PROPOSAL GUIDELINE

The proposal should generally conform to the following guidelines:

1. A clear and unambiguous title
2. An abstract of no more than 250 words
3. Background information to the proposed study, justification, objectives, key research questions and a research methodology

Note: It is understood that all of the above is tentative at this stage but should demonstrate the applicant's ability to present a coherent plan for research. It is also expected that the applicant demonstrates familiarity with conventions of academic writing and the ability to communicate her/his ideas clearly. The above structure is only for indicative purposes. The applicant may adopt a different format as long as it is a format generally accepted in academic proposals.

4. A tentative research plan with approximate deadlines for completing various stages of research – e.g., literature review, data collection, data analysis and writing, etc
6. A brief literature review – all citations in the APA format.
6. Length of the entire proposal (excluding abstract) to be between 3500 – 4000 words.

7. Formatting:

The proposal should be typed in Times New Roman 12pt (or an equivalent font) with 1.5 line spacing and 1" margins. Handwritten proposals will not be accepted.
